T.W. Frierson picks up \$600K in flood work

Two more large building permits for flood-related commercial rehabilitation work were issued Wednesday.

Gerdau Ameristeel received a building permit for \$325,000 worth of rehab work to its site on 110 North First St, located on the east bank of the Cumberland River and north of LP Field. According to the Gerdau Ameristeel Web site, the location is home to a sales, administration and sales office for its Nashville rebar operations. The work will be performed by T.W. Frierson Contractor Inc.

Upstream and across the river, at 860 Visco Drive, Stansell Electric Company has received a \$250,000 building permit for rehab work. The local electric contractor reports on its Web site that they have "completed extensive spring cleaning efforts prompted by the recent floods. We are back in our Nashville offices and warehouse." Stansell's rehab work will also be performed by T.W. Frierson Contractor Inc.
