

First New Marina In 31 Years Opens On Cumberland

ASHLAND CITY — Harpeth Shoals Marina opened to the public Saturday in Ashland City, making it the first new marina on the Cumberland River in 31 years.

The marina has permanent space for 143 boats, and the complete development will include two 10-story condominiums and a full-service restaurant.

Today gives Cheatham County a great destination for people to come," developer John Rankin said. "Middle Tennessee has one great asset, and that's the Cumberland River."

Harpeth Shoals officially opens to boat traffic June 1, and the Braxton condominiums are expected to open next spring, Rankin said.

Nearly 100 boat slips and condominiums have been sold.

Retirees Jim and Hazel Pierce of Brentwood said they bought a condominium and a boat slip to relax together during the week and entertain their five grandchildren on the weekend.

"We want to be able to enjoy the water and dock downtown," Hazel Pierce said.
